Please Note:

In order to demonstrate practical assessment items on video, you will require the following items

- A filming device
- A model or volunteer casualty
- Ice pack or frozen peas
- A compression bandage*
- A Triangular bandage*

(* can be purchased from your local pharmacy)



Assessment Instructions

Student must submit the following items, each may be on a separate video file

Item 1: Perform Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)

Learner MUST explain what they are doing to the video, the following items must be demonstrated and explained

- Following DRABCD guidelines
- Correct positioning of casualty for CPR
- Correct method of breathing
- Correct amount of head tilt according to age group of casualty
- Correct hand position for compressions
- Correct depth of compression (explain only)
- Correct rate of compressions: breathing
- Demonstration of correct recovery position

*please note, if using a live person as your model, compressions and breathing only need to be simulated

Item 2: Demonstrate one method of applying a sling

(utilizing one of the methods outlined in the instruction pdf)

Item 3: Demonstrate applying an ice pack to a sprained ankle using a compression bandage

(utilizing one of the methods outlined in the instruction pdf)

Item 4: Demonstrate and explain your management strategies for the following scenarios:

Scenario 1

Diagnosis

- Deep cut in his left upper leg which is spurting blood.
- Grazed right palm
- Pain to the upper right arm

Scenario 2

Diagnosis

- Deformed right lower leg
- Grazing to the right side of body
- Blood pumping from a deep gash near her left elbow
- Blurred Vision

Scenario 3

Diagnosis

- Rapid pulse and fast breathing
- Chest pain
- Pale, cold and starting to sweat.
- Signs of possible heart Attack
